



Senior Lecturer / Lecturer, Organisational Psychology

Overview:

The position will be primarily based at the Mt Gravatt campus, however the successful applicant will be expected to do some teaching and / or supervision at their non-resident campus as required.

The role:

The Lecturer or Senior Lecturer, Organisational Psychology will have a proven strong commitment to teaching excellence, and will actively and effectively supervise fourth year, masters and PhD research student projects. This position will bring experience in professional supervision and have a track record of research or scholarship. The role will also actively contribute toward administrative service and course coordination within the School.

The person:

The appointee will have a PhD in Psychology with demonstrated knowledge and skills in teaching and curriculum development at the tertiary education level in Organisational Psychology. They must have a proven ability in the administration of University courses and be able to supervise Honours, masters and PhD research students. The appointee will also demonstrate capacity to conduct and publish quality research or scholarship, capacity to attract internal and external research grant or consultancy funding, and demonstrate excellent interpersonal skills and readiness to contribute to both the School and University.

Salary range:

Senior Lecturer, Level C: \$111,104 - \$128,113 per annum. Salary package including 17% employer superannuation contribution: \$129,993 - \$149,893 per annum.
