Project Restore is seeking a professionally confident clinician to join our growing national team.

This role will suit a Specialist who is committed to our mission of restoring humanity, justice, and dignity where sexual harm has occurred and breaking the wider cycles of harmful sexual behaviour and violence now and for future generations.

About Us

Project Restore NZ (PRNZ) is the specialist national provider of restorative justice for sexual harm cases in Aotearoa. We have a contract with the Ministry of Justice to deliver restorative justice processes within the criminal justice system and the community as an alternative justice process.

This provides great potential for Survivor healing and recovery and the person who caused the harm to be accountable. We are implementing a long-term strategy which will grow our reach and impact, making this an exciting opportunity to have a very real, expanding and beneficial impact for Survivors.

About the Role

In this role you can truly make a difference. Working collaboratively with the Project Restore Team to support survivors to experience acknowledgement and validation of their emotional, physical, spiritual responses as a result of the harm they have experienced.

This will be achieved by:

1. Assisting with the intake assessment, preparation and ongoing risk and safety assessments for the person who caused the harm.
2. Providing clients with support, information, advocacy and guidance in the restorative justice process as part of a team of caseworkers adopting the three-legged stool Project Restore NZ model.
3. Developing effective professional relationships to extend our community profile and to provide information, recommendations and advocacy.
4. In the process of conducting this work to promote and work towards a society that is free from sexual violence.

As a minimum you will have;

- NZQA approved qualification in the field of counselling, social work, psychology, or psychotherapy, with at least four years' experience.
- Current full member of a professional counselling, psychotherapy, psychology, or social work body including a practicing certificate in relevant discipline
- Ability to meet criteria and maintain Ministry of Justice restorative justice accreditation of Sexual Violence specialist – working with sexual offending cases. Induction and training will
