

Fellowship

To qualify for election as a Fellow, a member must have satisfied the Executive that:

- (a) They have been a member of the Society for at least a total of seven years; and
- (b) They have made a substantial contribution to the advancement of psychological knowledge or practice either by their own research and/or practice or by organising or developing the work of others, and, normally
- (c) That they possess an advanced knowledge of psychology in at least one of its fields.
