What we need

We need clinical psychological services delivered to support New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) personnel within a Military Camp. This includes, but is not limited to staff wellbeing and clinical services, consultation with providers and stakeholders, training and broader organisational support.

Service providers must be registered clinical psychologists with at least five years post-graduate experience which includes a breadth of clinical experience in adult mental health, in particular assessment and treatment of trauma and PTSD.

Service providers must have experience with trauma informed CBT or EMDR (both would be ideal). Must have experience with depressive, anxiety and stressor related disorders and exposure to substance / addictive related disorders is. Experience with administering, interpreting and integrating psychometric tests is also required.

Please note: Applicants must be legally entitled to work in New Zealand (NZ) and be able to obtain and maintain the required level of NZ Government security clearance for the position applied for. The minimum citizenship and residency criteria for security clearances to be granted by the NZ Defence Force are as follows:

- Preferably a NZ citizen, who has resided in this country continuously for at least the last ten (10) years, OR
- Is a citizen of, and/or has resided continuously in one of more of the following countries for the last ten (10) years; either Australia, Canada, NZ, the United Kingdom (UK) or the United States of America (USA); and has a background history that is verifiable and can be assessed as appropriate by the NZ Security Intelligence Service (NZSIS) towards a recommendation of suitability for a security clearance at this level.

If you do not meet these minimum criteria, we will not be able to accept your application.
