The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to the leadership of an existing programme in ageing research. They will also be expected to teach developmental psychology with a focus on ageing, supervise post-graduate research students, and have experience in survey research methods and data analysis. We are particularly interested in candidates with demonstrated experience in attracting external research funding and a strong record of research stakeholder engagement and publication.
