The role will include contributing to further development of our suite of trauma interventions stemmed in the relational /attachment /neuroscience theoretical approaches. The successful applicant will have a solid foundation of ethical and culturally safe practice with the ability to work collaboratively within the wider Stand Tū Māia professional team.
