The online review day is 17 June. This is an opportunity to consolidate your learning from block one by exploring practical applications with real cases as well as asking any questions you might have.

It is expected that you will have completed our foundational training in <u>Working with Couples</u> <u>WWC</u> first or have equivalent training or experience. If you have not completed this, talk to us as we are willing to be flexible and hold a place for you if required for the WWC course later this year.
