
Auckland Geography and Events Survey: March 2019

For the Auckland Branch of New Zealand Psychological Society

Results Summary


- 1. 137 members and student subscribers responded (18.5%)
- 2. The majority of Auckland branch respondents want sub-branches to create communities of local psychologists
- 3. Either one-day or half-day trainings are the most popular events but require advance notice of at least one month (or longer for several people)
- 4. Cheaper PD is desirable in the \$50 \$200 range
- 5. Email notification is by far the best form of communication
- 6. About half of respondents would go to activities in the city fringe, and a quarter would go to events in north Auckland (most popular sub-branch area)
- 7. Emerging trends in psychology was the most popular topic choice, although many psychologists are too busy to attend
- 8. More interactive events such as interest groups, advocacy, networking, and discussions also appealed to smaller numbers of respondents
- 9. 37 members are prepared to assist in large or small ways (this is more than double the 10% who chose committee meetings from the events type list).

Question 1



- 1. Most popular event format = One day or half day training for 75% of respondents.
- 2. Second popular event format = Evening lecture or discussion for about half of respondents.
- 3. Third popular format = interest groups, forums via Zoom, or weekends for a third of respondents.




Other comments reinforced the desire to receive email alerts from national office. No other social media platform was suggested. (Respondents had received the survey invitation link via such an email).


Only 1 respondent skipped this question. The majority are in favour of sub-branches.
