

ANZAP 2021 TRAINING INTAKE

Offering a one-year extensive introduction to the theoretical framework of the Conversational Model with the option to complete Years 2 & 3

Applications are currently being accepted for training in the Conversational Model commencing in March 2021. This is an online training course.

The Conversational Model is a psychodynamic psychotherapy based on the work over many years by Prof Russell Meares and Dr Robert Hobson, incorporating developmental psychology, cognitive theory and attachment theory. It is a relational model, emphasising how early developmental relational trauma shapes many severe adult psychiatric problems and how to deal with this in short, medium and long-term therapy. The Model has been developed for a range of chronic psychiatric syndromes that are difficult to treat, particularly borderline personality disorder, dissociative disorders, other personality disorders, treatment resistant depression and somatic disorders.

It is an evidence-based treatment, with positive randomised controlled trials for the treatment of depression, deliberate self-harm, complex somatic disorders and borderline personality disorder. More importantly, the Conversational Model principles are practical and down-to-earth, and can be used even in emergency situations and one-off mental health assessments.

Our one-year extensive introduction course will focus on the short version of the Model. Practitioners will be able to integrate this into their clinical work. All suitable candidates will then be given the opportunity to extend this first year to another two years of in-depth training in psychodynamic work in the Conversational Model.

The training will be offered part-time with all seminars conducted interactive on-line in real time on Tuesday evenings (Sydney time). Supervision will be offered locally where possible, or on-line. Course fees cover:

- 28 weeks of Lectures and 28 weeks of Supervisions and on-line attendance at up to 4 Saturday morning seminars hosted by ANZAP.
- Providing Covid-19 restrictions allow, attendance at a weekend live-in student intensive in Sydney on 26-28 February 2021, (arrive Friday by 2 pm, finish lunch time Sunday). Fees cover cost of accommodation on Friday & Saturday night and all catering during the course of the weekend.
- A full day of group supervision in Sydney on Thursday, 14 October 2021.
- Attendance at ANZAP's pre-conference workshops in Sydney (2 workshops) on Friday 15
 October 2021. Students have the option to remain in Sydney for ANZAP's annual
 conference over the weekend on 16 & 17 October. A generous discount is offered to
 ANZAP students who register.
